

RULES & REGULATIONS INTERNATIONAL FLEET INDUSTRY AWARD 2018

Art 1 Organiser

The Fleet Europe Awards 2018 are organised by Nexus Communication, publisher of Fleet Europe Magazine and www.fleeteurope.com. Nexus Communication is established in Belgium (Parc Artisanal 11-13, B-4671 Barchon).

Art 2 General description of the Fleet Europe Awards 2018

The Fleet Europe Awards 2018 recognize the achievements of the finest fleet practices throughout Europe. This year the Fleet Europe Awards ceremony will take place in Barcelona, Spain, on November 28, 2018.

The International Fleet Industry Award is linked to the Fleet Europe Awards 2018 and is open for the international fleet supplier industry.

Art 3 Description of the International Fleet Industry Award 2018

The International Fleet Industry Award 2018 highlights innovative approaches, tools, products or services of the international fleet industry (manufacturers, leasing companies, or other fleet suppliers).

The jury (international fleet managers only, together with representatives of Nexus Communication) will vote for the best new tools, best innovative products and services designed to help international fleet managers achieve their goals in international fleet management.

Art 4 Eligibility

The International Fleet Industry Award 2018 is open to innovative projects developed by the automotive, vehicle fleet and mobility industry that enable international fleet and mobility managers to improve their fleet and mobility management at international level. The projects that can enter the competition are:

- **New Tools** designed to help international fleet and mobility managers improve their fleet and mobility management (car policy, reporting, online apps, driver communication, KPI optimisation...)
- **New Products and services** which help international fleet and mobility managers achieve their future goals (TCO, sustainability, safety, mobility, HR, fuel and CO2 reduction...)

Art 5 Jury

- The jury for the Fleet Europe Industry Award 2018 consists of international fleet managers and Nexus Communication team members.
- The decisions of the jury (70 % of the votes) are final and will be added to the votes made by the Fleet Europe summit's participants (30% of the votes) (see Art 8 Process and timing)
- The president of the jury, Steven Schoefs (chief editor Fleet Europe, Nexus Communication), is the only person in charge of announcing the results of the Fleet Europe Industry Awards 2018.

Art 6 Confidentiality

- All of the jury members are subject to the rules of ethics. They commit to not divulging any information concerning candidates, dossiers or results of the election.

Art 7 Registration

- Candidates for the International Fleet Industry Award 2018 must apply before September 10, 2018 by using the application form available at <http://forum.fleeteurope.com/programme/awards/> .

- The candidates are informed by the organiser about the validity of their candidacy upon application.
- The organiser sends the questionnaire for the constitution of the dossier to the candidate.
- The complete candidacy dossier must be entered before September 17, 2018. It must be emailed or sent to:

Art 8 Overall values and assessments

During the assessment of the dossiers, the jury will examine the following elements:

- The degree of innovation of the tool, product or service for the international fleet market
- The efficiency of the tool, product or service on the management of the fleet at international level
- The level of implementation of the innovative tool, product or service in the market
- The impact of the innovative tool, product or service on TCO reduction/control
- The further developments of the tool, product or service

Art 8 Process and timing

- Contestants apply before **September 10, 2018**. The organization confirms the validity of the candidacy to the candidates upon application.
- Contestants send their dossier before **September 17, 2018**.
- After receiving the dossiers of the candidates, the jury of the Fleet Europe Industry Award 2018 will select the 10 most innovative projects, upon receipt of the candidacy dossier and questionnaire. For the selection the jury evaluates all candidacy dossiers using a selection grid that you can find at <http://forum.fleeteurope.com/programme/awards/>.
- The final nominees will be contacted by the jury to defend their project via video conference mid-October, 2018. To become a winner the candidate must give the final presentation via video conference, as this jury meeting will represent 70% of the votes.
- The final nominees will also present their projects/service in a 5-minutes pitch on stage in the Fleet Europe Village, during the Fleet Europe Summit (November 28, 2018).
- Following these pitches, all participants of the Fleet Europe Summit 2018 will be able to vote for the best products/services via an online page (30% of the votes).
- The results of the voting will be unveiled during an Award Ceremony in the Fleet Europe Village on **November 28, 2018**. The best project(s) (Winner and Runner-up) will be rewarded on this occasion.

Nexus Communication asks all candidates to be present at this event. If there is any reason why a candidate cannot attend, a colleague or other nominated person should be delegated to present the 5-minutes pitch and to receive the prize on behalf of the nominee.

Art 9 Acceptance of rules

- Entering the Fleet Europe Awards 2018 entails acceptance of its rules and regulations and the decisions of the judges.
- Any attempt at fraud or corruption will be punished by immediate expulsion from the competition.
